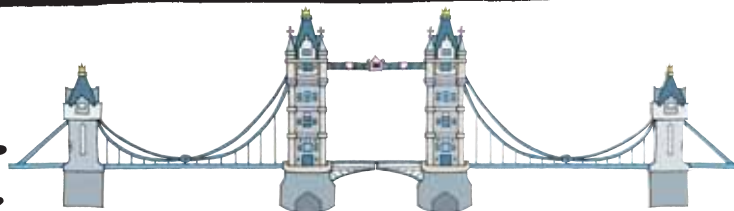


Guy Fox Explore Kit

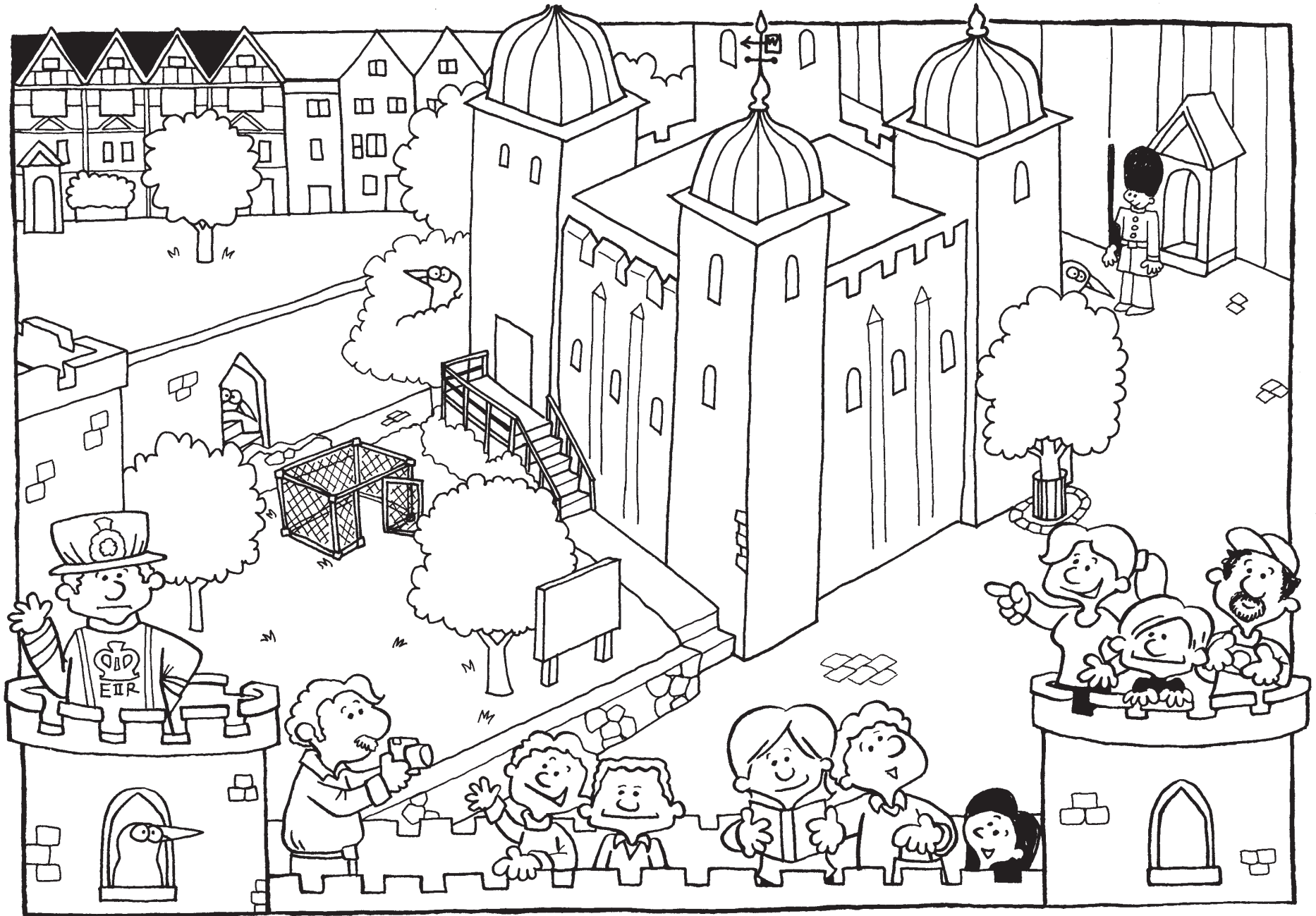
- ① Built the White Tower at the Tower of London.
- ② King when the Great Fire of 1666 destroyed 80% of the City of London.
- ③ Started the menagerie at the Tower of London.
- ④ Legend has it, the altar in the crypt of All Hallows Church was carried by this King on a Crusade.
- ⑤ Imprisoned in the Tower by her half-sister before she was Queen.
- ⑥ Queen when Tower Bridge opened in 1894.
- ⑦ Married six wives. Three of his children became monarchs themselves.
- ⑧ Became King after the mysterious deaths of Edward V and Prince Richard.
- ⑨ Tower Bridge was painted red, white & blue for her Silver Jubilee in 1977.
- ⑩ King when the HMS Belfast was launched in 1938.
